Workshop-cum-Visit at NFSU, Gandhinagar

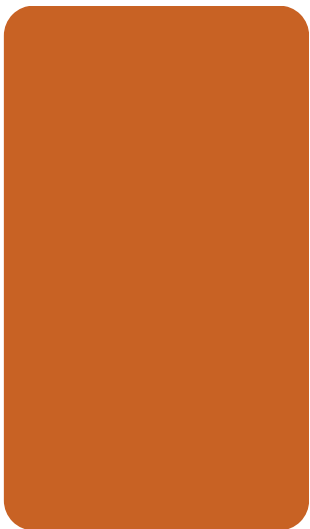
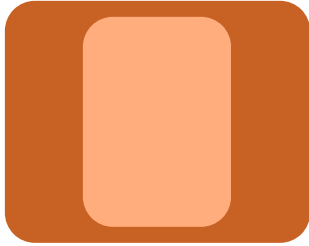
