About NFSU

The National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU), erstwhile Gujarat Forensic Sciences University (GFSU) is the world's first and only University dedicated to forensic science and its allied subjects. This unique University was envisioned by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi as the then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat in 2008 to be an institution of higher learning of international standard and to meet the huge shortfall of experts in the fields of forensic science across the world. It came into being on 11th February, 2009 at Gandhinagar, Gujarat with the appointment of Dr. J.M. Vyas as its first Director General. On 1st October 2020, the Government of India elevated the university into a National University and established NFSU through National Forensic Science University Act. Simultaneously, NFSU has also been accorded the status of an Institution of National Importance (INI).

On upgradation, the erstwhile GFSU has become the Gujarat campus of NFSU and the Lok Nayak Jayprakash Narayan- National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Sciences (LNJN NICFS) at Rohini, New Delhi as another campus. Seven more campuses/academy have been set up at Goa, Tripura, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Assam, Manipur and Karnataka. The headquarter of NFSU continues to be located at its ultra-modern and lush green campus at Gandhinagar, the capital city of a vibrant and industrious state of Gujarat.

About School of Management Studies, NFSU

School of Management Studies (SMS) is one of the constituent School of National Forensic Sciences University. At present, the school offers four post-graduate programs and one graduate program, explicitly, MBA in Forensic Accounting & Fraud Investigation, MBA in Hospital and Healthcare Management, MBA in Cyber Security Management, MBA in Business Intelligence and BBA-MBA. School of Management Studies with a solitary aim to create professionals and experts in the field of Forensic Management and Technology. 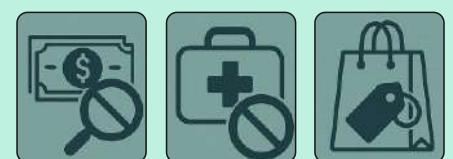

Guidelines for Paper Submission

- Research papers should be original unpublished works that follow the conference theme.
- The articles must be written in English & submitted in PDF format only.
- Word limit would be 200 to 250 words for abstract and around 4,500 - 5000 words for research paper. Abstract should specify the research objectives, methodology and major findings.
- Suggested structure of the research paper: Introduction, Review of Literature, Research Gap, Research Methodology, Major Findings, Contributions of the study, Limitations and Scope for Further Research.
- Text should be written in A4 size, Times New Roman, font size-12 with 1.5 line spacing.
- Reference style should be APA (7th edition).
- In each case, plagiarism of any kind (beyond 10%) is not acceptable & excessive use of AI will lead to rejection of article.
- Selected research papers have the opportunity to be published in NJFAFI, which is a Journal of School of Management Studies, National Forensic Sciences University, Gandhinagar, on a merit basis. The journal requirements for publication have to be met by the authors. All other papers will be published in a book bearing ISBN number.
- "The organizers are currently in preliminary discussions with publishers of Scopus-indexed journals. A few high-quality papers will be recommended for publication on a merit basis, provided the authors meet the journal guidelines and are willing to pay the Article Processing Charges (APC)."

Mode of Conduct

The conference will be conducted in offline mode only. Participants can present their work only by registering and being physical present.
