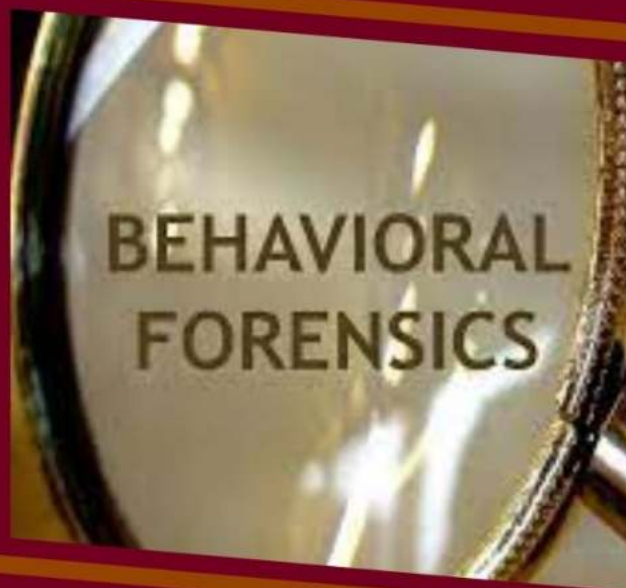
Gandhinagar Campus is the first campus of the National Forensic Sciences University at Gandhinagar, Gujarat. National Forensic Sciences University is running 64 courses in the twelve schools.

NFSU currently offers graduate and postgraduate -level academic programs in advanced and specialized courses run by each school along with M.Phil and Ph.D. programs. Maintaining excellence in education, research, and training with appropriate facilities within this campus, NFSU encourages collaborations across multiple disciplines and skill sets.

The University conducts need-based customized training programs for the Police Officers, Judicial Officers, Forensic Experts, Security Officers, Medical Officers, Legal Officers, Army Officers, Senior Vigilance Officers of Banking, Insurance sectors, Forest Officers, Officers of NIA, NDCB, IAS Officers, IFS Officers, Officers of CBI, Income tax, Public and Private Sector undertaking.



The University is empanelled training institute of Ministry of External Affairs under ITEC scheme of Government of India. The University conducts around 40 to 50 training programs for foreign police officers, judges and forensic scientists of more than 65 countries. ABOUT INDIAN SOCIETY OF CRIMINOLOGY

The ISC was established in the year 1970, with the objectives of advancing the study and application of Criminology and Allied Sciences, for the welfare of the society. It also endeavored to facilitate cooperation among professionals interested in the prevention and control of crime, which has escalated over time. Over a short span, the ISC developed into a pioneering National organization, due to the cumulative efforts of its dedicated founders. The society was initiated by professionals, namely, Professor T. E. Shanmugam; Mr. Pitchandi; Justice V. R. Krishna Iyer; Mr. Pon Paramaguru, IPS; Professor K. Chockalingam; and Mr. K. Mani.

Consistent with the multi-disciplinary character of the science of criminology, the society targets professionals such as criminologists, psychologists, sociologists, judges, lawyers, police officers, correctional officers, forensic scientists, social workers, child protection specialists, probation officers, criminal justice practitioners and others works in the area of prevention of crime and salvaging the humanity from the law breakers.

PAPER SUBMISSION & REGISTRATION

Participants can submit their abstract at the given email address: 44th.isc.conference@nfsu.ac.in.

Participants are requested to submit their full papers at the time of registration for the Conference. The full paper should be between **4,000-7,000 words** in length in APA format, and should be accompanied with an abstract of not more than 300 words. The papers may fall under any of the sub-themes for the Conference, or be related to any other topic under the broad theme of the Conference.

The following guidelines should be followed by the authors while writing the paper:

1. Type and double-space your paper on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11") with 1" margins on all sides.
2. Include a page header (or running head) with your paper title and the page number at the top of every page.
3. Indent the first line of every paragraph 0.5 inches.
4. Use an accessible font (such as Times New Roman 12pt.).
5. Include a page number on every page.

ISC BEST RESEARCH PAPER AWARD - OPEN SCIENTIFIC SESSION

The Indian Society of Criminology awards one Gold medal and one Silver Medal (with cash prize Rs. 5000 and Rs. 3000, respectively) for the best research papers in the field of Criminology, Criminal Justice and allied fields. The research paper should be an outcome of scientific/ empirical research carried out between 2021 - 2023 by young practitioner/ research scholars/ students below 35 years of age (kindly attach birth certificate or Class 10-mark statement for age proof duly attested by the Head of the Department/ gazetted officer). 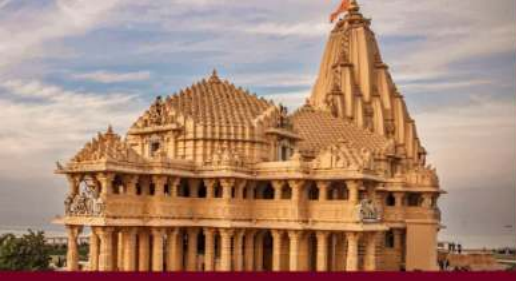
