#### **National Forensic Sciences University**

National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU), erstwhile Gujarat Forensic Sciences University, was established by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri. Narendra Modiji, in 2009, with the sole objective of creating professional experts in the field of forensic sciences. Since its inception, the University has been scaling new heights with its extraordinary and exemplary performances in the field of academics and Forensic Sciences. Based on the impressive successes achieved by this university within a short span of eleven years, the Government of India has recognized its services and has accorded the status of Institution of National Importance in October 2020 through Act 2020 (32 of 2020).
