NFSU CAMPUS LAUNCHED IN BHOPAL BY HON'BLE HOME MINISTER, SHRI AMIT SHAH



Hon'ble Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, laid the foundation stone for the new Campus of NFSU at Bhopal, the capital city of Madhya Pradesh (M.P.), on 22nd August 2022. The permanent campus will come up at Barkheda Bondar near Madhya Pradesh Police Academy while the temporary campus has been set-up within the Central Forensic Science Laboratory (CFSL) building. Due to extremely heavy rains, *Bhoomi Pujan* and *Shilanyas* for the permanent campus were performed remotely and the temporary campus was inaugurated virtually at Rabindra Bhavan. It was combined with a function marking inauguration of buildings for M.P. Police. The event was attended by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of M.P., Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan; Hon'ble Home Minister of M.P., Dr. Narottam Mishra; and Hon'ble Urban Development and Housing Minister of M.P., Shri Bhupendra Singh. Union Home Secretary, Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla; Addl. Chief Secretary, Home Department of M.P., Dr. Rajesh Rajora; DGP of M.P., Shri Sudhir Saxena; Additional Secretary in the Ministry of Home Affairs, Shri Shyamal Mishra; and many other dignitaries also attended the event. All the dignitaries were received by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of NFSU, Dr. J.M. Vyas. He was accompanied by the Campus Director of NFSU's Delhi Campus, Prof. (Dr.) S.O. Junare, Executive Registrar of NFSU, Shri C.D. Jadeja; Campus Director of NFSU's Gujarat Campus, Prof. (Dr.) Purvi Pokhariyal; and Campus Director of NFSU's Goa Campus, Prof. (Dr.) N.K. Chaudhary.





The function began with Dr. J.M. Vyas thanking the Hon'ble Home Minister for extending all the help and guidance towards establishing the Bhopal campus. He also thanked the Hon'ble C.M. for allotting 27 acres of land for this campus. He brought out that with ever increasing sophistication in offences, there is a need for experts to solve such intricate and complicated crimes. It is in this backdrop that the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi and the Hon'ble Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah as the then C.M. and H.M. of Gujarat, decided not only to establish this forensic science university but now also setup campuses across the country. He said this campus will not only serve the state of M.P. but will also become an international centre with training for foreign countries also being planned here. He added that National Forensic Sciences University is starting four courses from the academic year-2022-23 at Bhopal Campus which are M.Sc. Forensic Science, P.G. Diploma in DNA Forensics, P.G. Diploma in Fingerprint Science and P.G. Diploma in Forensic Document Examination. Addressing the gathering, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan brought that establishment of a NFSU campus at Bhopal is not a normal event because it is a campus of the world's first and the only forensic sciences university, which is not only running 72 courses but training officials from 70 different countries. He said that the nation is grateful to the Hon'ble P.M. and Hon'ble C.M. for creating this unique university. Referring to the gratitude conveyed by Dr. Vyas, he announced that whatever land is required will be made available for the Bhopal campus.

Shri Amit Shah addressed the gathering by appreciating NFSU for gaining worldwide fame in a short span of 12-13 years. He said students of Madhya Pradesh who want to make a career in forensic science will no longer be required to go anywhere. He said he is confident that this campus will provide an opportunity to the youth to work in forensics at the national and international level as students from number of countries would be studying here in next few years. Shri Shah added that training will also be conducted for police officers, judicial officers, prosecution lawyers and private industries. He said that the Ministry of Home Affairs has prepared an action plan under the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi. The four pillars of this action plan are - increasing the number of forensic science laboratories, rapidly increasing forensic experts, providing of forensic technology and promoting R&D. Hon'ble Home minister concluded adding that setting of this campus of NFSU is step forward in this direction. His address was followed by presentation of shawl and a memento to the dignitaries by Prof. (Dr.) Purvi Pokhariyal, and Shri C.D. Jadeja presenting a vote of thanks, wherein he whole heartedly thanked all the guests and organisers.

The entire event was led from the front by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Dr. J.M. Vyas with able support of Prof. Junare and Shri Jadeja. Dr. Parag Rughani, Associate Professor and Faculty Incharge of Bhopal campus, undertook overall coordination of the arrangements, along with Dr. Malay Shukla, and Dr. Pranav Dave, both Asst Professors of NFSU. Dr. Astha Pandey and Dr. Meroool Vakil, both Asso. Professors; Dr. Dharmesh Dave, Assistant Professor, and Shri Nirav Karia too supported in the conduct of the event. Although the function as envisaged could not take place at the actual site due to unusually heavy rains, Team NFSU received immense support from Dr. Rajesh Rajora, ACS Home Department; Shri Avinash Lavania, D.M. Bhopal; and Shri Dileep Yadav, ADM Bhopal who extended wholehearted support to NFSU.

The Meet was jointly presided over by Dr. J.M. Vyas, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of NFSU and the country's senior-most forensic scientist, and Dr. S.K. Jain, Director-Cum-Chief Forensic Scientist, DFSS, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi. The meet was attended by Directors of CFSLS and SFSLS, and Campus Directors of NFSU.



REGIONAL CONSULTATION ON "REVIEW OF THE FAMILY COURTS ACT, 1984"



The Western Regional Consultation on "Review of the Family Courts Act, 1984" was organized by NFSU in association with the National Commission for Women on 25th July 2022. The Inaugural Session was attended by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ravikumar Tripathi, Chairperson, Gujarat State Human Rights Commission; Ms. Sarla Som, Assistant Law Officer, National Commission for Women; Dr. J.M. Vyas, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of NFSU; and Prof. (Dr.) Purvi Pokhariyal, Gujarat Campus Director along with academicians, judicial officers, investigative agency officers and industry experts. The regional consultation was divided into two sessions. In the Preliminary Session, besides Prof. (Dr.) Purvi Pokhariyal, Mr. Anil Pratham, Directorate General of Police, Gujarat Police; Dr. Shekhar Seshadri, Senior Professor & Advisor – SAMVAD, NIMHANS; Dr. Jyotsna Yagnik, Former Principal Judge, City Civil and Sessions Court, Ahmedabad; Madam Kalpana Vin, former principal judge, Family Court, Ahmedabad and many other experts participated as panellists. The issues discussed were significance of mediation, conciliation, and negotiation in family disputes; role of advocates; pre-litigation mediation; psychological impact on women and children. In the Concluding session, the panellists were Prof. (Dr.) Beulah Shekhar, Dean, School of Behavioural Studies, NFSU; Prof. (Dr.) P. Lakshmi, Dean, United World School of Law, Karnawati University, Gandhinagar; Prof. (Dr.) Debarati Halder, Professor, Parul University, Vadodara; Dr. Babu Gauda, Associate Professor, Salgaokar Law College, Goa; Dr. Tarkesh Molia, Associate Professor, NFSU; and number of faculty from different universities and advocates. In this session, discussions were on the challenges of the Family Courts Act and role of counsellor and social welfare and medical agencies were highlighted. The experts suggested several recommendations which were forwarded to the National Commission for Women. They mainly concerned the need of a family court manual which shall provide a uniform structure in managing and handling family court matters; continuous and special training for family court judges; pre-litigation proceedings in order to avoid overburdening; and recommendation that family settlement made must be in the best interest of the child.

5- DAY CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME ON FORENSIC JUSTICE



A 5-day Capacity Building Programme on Forensic Justice was organised by the NFSU's School of Law, Forensic Justice and Policy Studies (SLFJPS) from 26th to 30th July 2022. It was aimed at holistic understanding of forensic science and law together. Prof. (Dr.) Purvi Pokhariyal, Campus Director and Dean of SLFJPS, welcomed the participants and stressed on how legal faculty members need to develop a coherent understanding between the two disciplines. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dr. J.M. Vyas, delivered the presidential address and stressed on how adequate understanding of science and law together can lead to an effective justice delivery system. He also gave illustrations of how science can give law students an expansive understanding of the inter-disciplinary fields and an edge over their peers. Amongst other speakers, Dr. Shekhar Seshadri, Senior Professor & Advisor, SAMVAD-NIMHANS addressed on the duality of the concept of child and forensics and how it can lead to a better understanding of child witnesses. Dr. G.K. Goswami, ADGP, Uttar Pradesh Police, discussed issues and challenges of DNA Forensics. Dr. Jyotsana Yagnik, former Principal Judge, City Civil and Sessions Courts, Ahmedabad, took the session on the Use of Forensic Science in the Justice Administration System to enable judiciary to reach the correct conclusion. Dr. Rukmani Krishnamurthy, Chairperson & CEO, HELIK Advisory Ltd., shared her experience of working on some important cases and brought out the radical changes required in the forensics. Shri Keshav Kumar, former DGP of Anti-Corruption Bureau of Gujarat, discussed the significance of DNA evidence in the criminal investigation and Anti-corruption. Hon'ble Justice Subodh Shah, former Judge of Gujarat High Court, spoke on the significance of forensics. Additionally, Prof. (Dr.) Naveen Kumar Chaudhary, Dr. Astha Pandey, Dr. Beulah Shekhar, Dr. Pooja Ahuja, Dr. Surbhi Mathur, Dr. Haresh Barot, Dr. Bhargava Patel, Dr. Abraham Johnson, and other faculty members of NFSU discussed on the concepts of legal dentistry, digital forensics, drug forensics, crime scene management, audio video forensics, DNA forensics, forensic accounting, law, and other disciplines.

NFSU CO-HOSTS 'SECURE INDIA CONFERENCE

NFSU co-hosted a 3-day online conference on the theme 'Secure India' with the Global Counter terrorism Council (GCTC) from 12th July to 14th July 2022. The conference deliberated on Internal Security threats, Challenges & Responses within India and neighboring countries. 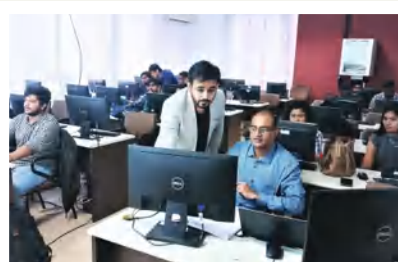
DEMONSTRATION ON WORKING OF INSAS RIFLE BY CISF STAFF

WORKSHOP ON VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT AND PENETRATION TESTING

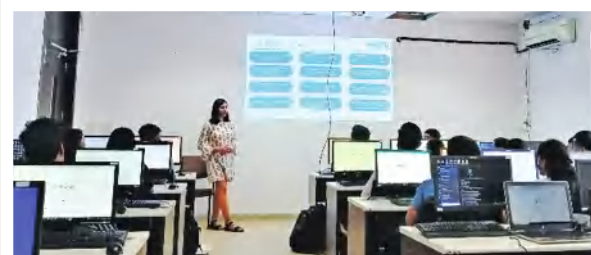

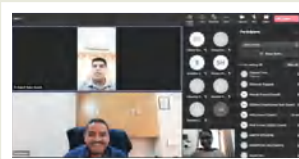

NFSU's School of Engineering and Technology (SET) offered consultancy services for assessment of fire damaged Industrial Steel Structure at Ahmedabad. An Industrial warehouse at Navapura, Sanand, Ahmedabad had caught fire on 19th April 2022. Structural steel trusses, purlins, roofing sheets and masonry brick walls were affected due to fire. Dr. Merool Vakil, Associate Professor for Forensic Structural Engineering at the SET, along with team members, Prof. R. J. Shah and Mr. Abhi Shah, took up the consultancy work for investigation and evaluation of fire damaged structure.
