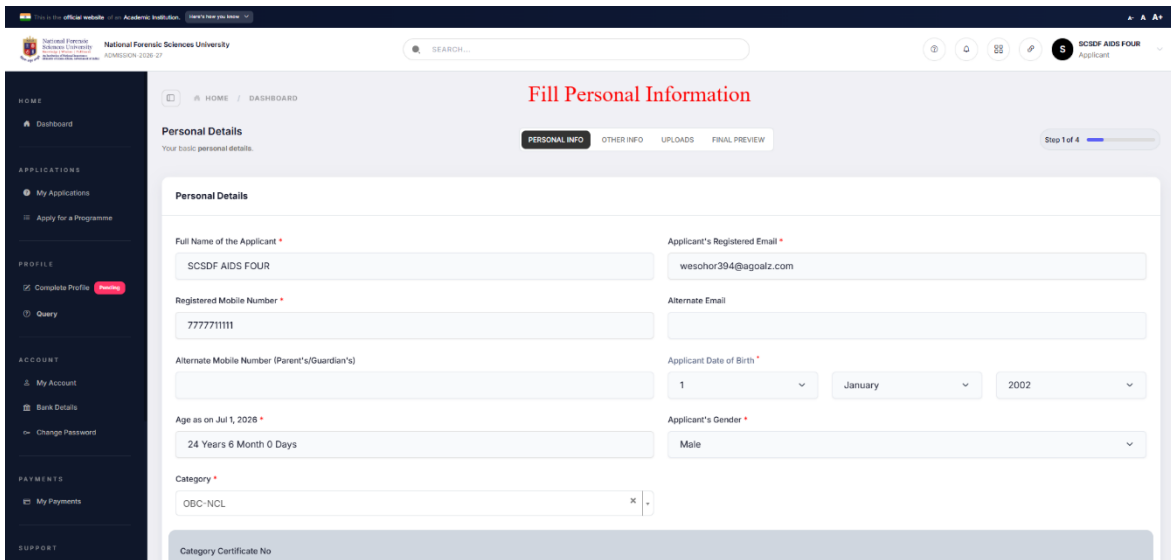
- After the successful completion of the registration process, Applicants login to complete the personal profile by clicking the Complete Profile button.
