**Terms & Conditions of Appointment:**

Candidates having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant discipline with a minimum first class or 60% or equivalent at the preceding degree in the relevant discipline from a recognized university with a very good academic record throughout shall be considered for the post of Assistant Professor (contractual) and will be paid consolidated remuneration of Rs 90000/- per month.

In case qualified and suitable candidates are not found for the post of Assistant Professor in any discipline, the University may appoint contractual faculty at lower remuneration, as per the following criteria:

1. Candidates with a Master's degree in the relevant discipline with a minimum First Class or 60% (or equivalent) from a recognized university, having a consistently good academic record and qualified CSIR/UGC-NET – Assistant Professor in the relevant subject, shall be considered for the post of Assistant Professor (Contractual) with a consolidated remuneration of Rs.75,000 per month.
2. In case the NET examination is not conducted by the University Grants Commission in the concerned subject, candidates with a Master's degree with a minimum First Class or 60% (or equivalent) and a very good academic record shall be considered for the post of Assistant Professor (Contractual) with a consolidated remuneration of Rs.68,000 per month. Preference shall be given to candidates pursuing their Ph.D. from any Institute of National Importance (INI) or a recognized university.

**Important Note:**

1. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure his/her eligibility for the post before appearing for the Interview.
2. Candidate will be allowed to appear before the interview panel, subject to his/her eligibility.
3. Depending on the number of candidates for the post, interviews may go till late in the day or may need to be conducted on the subsequent day. The candidates are required to make their arrangements accordingly.

**General Instructions, Essential Information, and Clarifications:**

1. The qualifications and experience of candidates shall be reckoned as on the last date of submission of the application.
2. The prescribed Essential Qualifications are a bare minimum and mere possession of it, will not entitle the candidates to be considered for the post. The candidates should furnish all the Qualifications and Experience possessed in the relevant field, over and above the minimum qualifications prescribed for consideration of their candidature.
3. In case the candidates who do not possess Ph.D. Degree but are pursuing Ph.D. in Forensic science or its allied branches or other relevant disciplines at any INI or reputed University / Institute, or NET-AP qualified in relevant subject and have good academic record throughout may be considered.
4. Applicants are required to submit valid documentary proof in support of any change of name (if applicable), such as a Marriage Certificate, Gazette Notification, or Aadhaar Card.

5. Wherever grading or any other system than the percentage is followed, the result of the candidate should be converted into a percentage on the basis of the percentage conversion table declared by the concerned university.
6. The posts listed above are purely temporary and on a contractual basis for a period of 11 months, which may be extended based on performance and institutional requirements, or until a regular incumbent is appointed, whichever is earlier.
7. The interview will be conducted in offline mode only; requests for online interviews shall not be entertained.
8. The University shall verify the antecedents and documents submitted by candidates at any stage, including after appointment. If at any time it is found that the documents are false or the candidate has concealed material information or has an undesirable background, his/her services shall be liable to termination.
9. In case of any inadvertent error in the selection process detected at any stage, even after issuance of the appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify, withdraw, or cancel any communication made to the candidate.
10. Candidates must produce all original documents related to educational qualifications, experience, and other relevant credentials at the time of the interview, failing which their candidature shall be cancelled.
11. Candidates presently in service under the Central/State Government, Semi-Government organisations, or Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) shall be required to produce a No Objection Certificate (NOC) obtained from their respective employer at the time of interview.
12. Canvassing in any form by or on behalf of a candidate shall lead to disqualification.
13. Notwithstanding anything contained herein, the University reserves the right to:
  - a) Offer a post at a lower level than advertised, based on the candidate's qualifications, experience, and performance, with relaxation of requirements;
  - b) Prepare a reserve panel for anticipated future vacancies;
  - c) Consider candidates in absentia, including those who may not have applied or who may have applied for higher positions;
  - d) Relax qualifications, experience, or age criteria at its discretion;
  - e) Not fill any or all advertised positions.
14. The medium of instruction for all courses conducted in the Schools, Centres, and Departments of the University shall be English.
15. The University reserves the right:
  - a) To withdraw the advertisement, either wholly or partly, at any time without assigning any reason;
  - b) To fill or not to fill any or all the posts;
  - c) To increase or decrease the number of posts following due procedure.
16. The University shall not be responsible for any loss of communication due to incorrect email details provided by the candidate.
17. No TA/DA shall be admissible for attending the interview.
18. All communication to the eligible candidate shall be made through email only.
19. In case of any dispute or ambiguity arising during the selection process, the decision of the University in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of applications, mode of selection, and conduct of examination/interview shall be final, and no correspondence shall be entertained.
20. Candidates possessing degrees, diplomas, or certificates from institutions declared fake or derecognized by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi, shall not be eligible for consideration.
21. Appointment shall be subject to the candidate being in sound mental and physical health and free from any condition that may interfere with the efficient discharge of duties.

23. All documents submitted by candidates must be properly indexed, serially numbered and self-attested.
