IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

- 1.** Candidates are advised to report at the Examination Centre well in time before commencement of the examination.
- 2.** The candidate must show, on-demand, the documents for admission in the examination room/hall. The Test Centre Staff on duty is authorized to verify the identity of candidates and may take steps to verify and confirm the identity credentials. Candidates are requested to extend their full cooperation. A candidate who does not possess a valid Application Form printout and authorized Photo ID shall not be permitted to take the examination under any circumstances by the Centre Superintendent.

- 3.** The candidate should ensure that the Question Paper available on the computer is as per his/her opted Programme indicated in the Application Form printout. In case, the name of the Question Paper is other than his/her opted Programme, the same may be brought to the notice of the Invigilator concerned.
- 4.** For those who are unable to appear on the scheduled date of test for any reason, re-test shall not be held by the NFSU under any circumstances.
- 5.** Candidates are not allowed to carry any baggage inside the Examination Centre. NFSU will not be responsible for any belongings stolen or lost at the premises.
- 6.** Candidates will not be permitted to enter the examination hall after 09:45 AM and must remain in the hall until at least 11:00 AM or until the end of the examination. No entry to or exit from the examination premises is allowed outside these times under any circumstances. NFSU will not be responsible for any delays in your arrival at the center. Candidates are advised to familiarize themselves with the location of the test center and plan their travel time accordingly.
- 7.** Identity checks will be made upon arrival at the test centre to ensure that there are no unauthorized candidates appearing for the test. Candidates are required to cooperate with the security personnel for security check.
- 8.** No candidate, without the special permission of the Centre Superintendent or the Invigilator concerned, will leave his/her seat or Examination Room/Hall until the full duration of the paper is over. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as instructed by the Centre Superintendent/Invigilators.
- 9.** Please note that only registered candidates will be allowed at the Examination Centre. Friends or relatives accompanying the candidates shall not be allowed entry in the test centre under any circumstances and will not be allowed to contact the candidate while the Examination processes going on.
- 10.** At the test Centre, each candidate will be seated at a desk with a computer terminal and they will be provided with sheets of paper for doing rough work. Candidates are to write their Application Number and name on the Rough Sheets. After the test, candidate must drop the Rough Papers in the drop box kept for the purpose. Rough work cannot be done on any other paper/sheet, as nothing will be allowed inside the Examination Room/Hall.
- 11.** The candidates are to be governed by the Rules and Regulations/Instruction of the NFSU with regard to their conduct in the Examination Hall. All cases of unfair means will be dealt with as per rules.
- 12.** Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected and such candidates will be further debarred from appearing in examinations conducted by NFSU.

13. NFSU reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently if any, to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the PhD Admission Test even though the intimation of appearing in the Test had been issued by the NFSU.

Note: Candidates shall appear at their own cost at the Centre on the Date, Subject and timing of Examination as issued by the NFSU.

Candidates MUST bring the following documents on the day of examination at the test center. Candidates who will not bring these will not be allowed to sit in the examination.

b. Any one of the authorized photo IDs (must be original, valid, and nonexpired) – University/College Identity Card/ PAN card/ Driving License/ Voter ID/ Passport/ Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/E-Aadhaar with photograph/ Ration Card with photograph/ Bank Passbook with Photograph.

c. PwBD certificate issued by the authorized medical officer, if claiming the relaxation under PwBD category

OR

PwBD Certificate regarding physical limitation in an examination to write as per Annexures given in Information Bulletin, if claiming the relaxation under PwBD category.

d. A simple transparent Ball Point Pen.

No other item will be permitted to be carried inside the examination hall.

ROUGH WORK

All calculations/writing work is to be done only in the Rough Sheet provided at the Test Centre in the Examination Room/Hall and on completion of the test, candidates must hand over the Rough Sheets to the Invigilator on duty in the Room/Hall.
