### Important Instructions

#### 1. Tie Breaking Rules:

In case of equal marks in Bachelor's degree, the following tie-breaking rules (as already notified in the policy) will be applied:

##### a. For UG:

- The merit will be determined based on the percentage of Class XII.
- If the percentages in Class XII are also the same, the percentage of Class X will be considered.

##### b. For PG:

- Priority will be given to candidates whose results for the qualifying degree are available. The merit will be determined based on the percentage. If the result is in CGPA/CPI, it will be converted into percentage using the respective University's formula.
- The candidates whose results of the final semester/year has not been declared will then be considered for merit. The merit of these candidates will be based on the cumulative percentage of all semesters/years except the last semester/year.

#### 2. Counselling Schedule

A separate email containing the WEBEX link has been sent to the registered email ID of all the candidates who are called for counselling.

- It is mandatory for all candidates in the merit list to attend the online counselling session (through WEBEX link provided by email) to secure admission for the above program. This counselling session will provide you with important information about the admission process, course details, and other relevant information.
- The Admission Counselling process shall be as follows:
  - You need to join the admission counselling ONLINE via the WEBEX link provided in the email well within the time. You are required to keep your NFSU application number, one valid photo ID card (Aadhar card/Passport/Driving License/Election Voter ID) in original.
  - The Admission Counsellor will call out your ATTENDANCE and mark your presence during the counselling session. It is your sole responsibility to respond to the call for marking your presence, failing which you shall be considered ABSENT and shall not be considered for the future process of admission.



- c. Once you confirm your willingness to take admission, the Admission Counsellor will send you an email (at your registered email ID) to make the payment.
  - d. If you fail to attend the counselling session or choose not to opt for the admission process, you shall be deemed to have relinquished your claim for admission to NFSU, and your seat shall be given to the next person in Merit.
5. After receiving the "Provisional Admission Offer Email" which contains the payment link, you need to make the payment of Semester Fees of Rs. 47,500. Please make sure of the following points (a to f) to avoid problems during online transactions.
- a. Ensure you have good and stable internet connection.
  - b. Please check the daily withdrawal limit for the bank account/debit card/credit card/UPI/Wallet.
  - c. Please check if e-commerce transactions are activated or enabled on your credit card.
  - d. If the amount is debited from your bank account and transaction is showing as failed or pending, please wait as we update it within one (1) hour.
  - e. After one (1) hour, if the transaction is still showing as failed/pending, the bank will auto-refund your amount within seven (7) working days.
