**Important Instructions**

**1. Tie Breaking Rules:**

In case of the equal Marks in NFAT-2024 (i.e. same merit number), the following tie-breaking rules (as already notified in the policy) will be applied:

- a. For UG Programs:
  - The merit will be determined based on the percentage of Class XII.
  - If the percentages in Class XII are also the same, the percentage of Class X will be considered.
- b. For PG Programs
  - Priority will be given to candidates whose results for the qualifying degree are available. The merit will be determined based on the percentage. If the result is in CGPA/CPI, it will be converted into a percentage using the respective university's formula.
  - The candidates whose result of the final semester/year has not been declared will then be considered for the merit. The merit of these candidates will be based on the cumulative percentage of all semesters/years except the last semester/year.

**2. Counselling Schedule:**

Venue: Online Mode through WEBEX Platform

(A separate email containing the WEBEX link has been sent to the registered email ID of all the candidates who are called for the counselling)

3. It is mandatory for all candidates in merit to attend the online counselling session (through WEBEX link provided by email) to secure admission to the above program. This counselling session will provide you with important information about the admission process, course details, and other relevant information.

4. The Admission Counselling process shall be as follows:

1. You need to join the admission counselling ONLINE via the above link well within the time. You are required to keep your NFSU Application Number, One Valid Photo ID card (AADHAR Card/Passport/Driving License/Election Voter ID) in Original.

2. The Admission Counsellor would call your ATTENDANCE and mark your presence in the counselling session. It is your sole responsibility to respond to your presence call failing which you shall be considered ABSENT and shall not be considered for the further process of admission.
3. Once you confirm your willingness to take admission, the Admission Counsellor will send you an email (at Registered email ID) to make the payment.
4. If you fail to attend the Counselling session or choose not to opt for admission process, you shall be deemed to have relinquished your claim for admission to NFSU and your seat shall be given to the next person in Merit.
5. After receiving the "Provisional Admission Offer Email" which contains the payment link, you need to make payment of **First Semester fees of INR 74,000 (Seventy Four Thousands only)**. Please make sure of the following points (a to f) to avoid problems during online transactions.
  - a. Ensure you have a good internet connection.
  - b. Please check the daily withdrawal limit for the bank account/debit card/credit card/UPI/wallet
  - c. Please check if e-commerce transactions are activated or enabled on your credit card.
  - d. If amount is debited from your bank account and transaction is failed or pending, please wait we will update it within One (1) hour
  - e. After One (1) hour if transaction is still failed, bank will auto-refund your amount within Seven (7) working days.

6. Once you pay the fees, you will receive the payment receipt via email at your registered email ID.
