With the approval of the Competent Authority, NFSU Dharwad Campus is inviting interested firms/vendors for the sale of empty carton boxes and old newspapers on an “as is/ where is” basis through auction. The auction details are as follows:

3. Eligibility Criteria for Bidders:

(i) The bidder must be a registered firm/agency/company.

(ii) The bidder must possess valid licenses/registrations from the Karnataka State Pollution Control Board (KSPCB) and/or Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) for handling,



recycling, and/or disposal of paper/cardboard waste. A copy of such valid certificate/license must be enclosed.

(iii) If the bidder is a re-seller, a declaration stating that the scrap will be sold to a vendor registered with the KSPCB / CPCB must be enclosed.

(iv) The bidder should have a valid PAN/TAN and GSTIN.

(v) The bidder should not have been blacklisted by any Government Department / PSU / Autonomous Body.

4. Terms & Conditions:

(i) **As Is, Where Is & Whatever There is Basis:** The materials are sold in their current physical condition. The University offers no guarantees regarding quality, weight, or usability.

(ii) **Weightment:** The responsibility of arranging and bearing all costs related to the weightment of the waste carton boxes at the time of lifting shall lie entirely with the successful bidder. The actual weight of the material will be jointly recorded in the presence of authorized representatives of NFSU Dharwad Campus and the bidder/bidder's representative at the time of removal and the total payable amount shall be calculated accordingly based on the approved bid rate per kg.

(iii) **Award of Auction:**

(a) The auction shall be awarded to the **highest bidder (H1)** quoted above the base price.

(b) The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded immediately after completion of auction.


(c) The EMD of successful bidder will be adjusted against the final payment.

(iv) **Payment Terms:** The successful bidder will be required to make the full payment for the auctioned material within 3 working days from the date of issuance of the work order, through a Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque in favour of "NFSU Dharwad Campus. All applicable taxes (e.g., GST, etc.) shall be borne by the successful bidder as per prevailing government rules. Lifting of material will be permitted only after the full payment has been received and cleared.

(v) **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):** A refundable Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of ₹3,000/- is required to participate in the auction. The amount shall be remitted prior to the commencement of the auction and will be refunded after completion of the auction.

(vi) **Forfeiture:** In case the successful bidder fails to make the full payment or remove the material within the prescribed time, the EMD shall be forfeited and the university may, at its discretion, offer the material to the next highest bidder or re-auction the material.

- (vii) The successful bidder shall produce valid Pollution Control Board (PCB) authorization, if required, for handling waste paper/cardboard disposal.
- (viii) **Scrap Disposal:** The bidder is responsible for all transportation, handling and lawful disposal complying strictly with Central and Karnataka State Waste Management Rules. Disposal must be eco friendly and in accordance with the waste disposal guidelines issued by the concerned authorities
- (ix) The cost towards transportation, loading, unloading, labour charges, and all incidental expenses shall be borne entirely by the successful bidder.
- (x) The contractor must complete the collection of materials within three (3) days from the date of award of contract. After this period, the University shall not be responsible for safe custody of the materials.
- (xi) The contractor shall strictly abide by all the terms and conditions of the auction.
- (xii) Any dispute arising out of this auction shall fall under the jurisdiction of Dharwad only.
