(m) Certificate of No Deviation As per Annexure – 4

(n) Scanned copy of Manufacturer Authorization as attached at Annexure -5, if quoted on behalf of

Principle Manufacturer / Company / Importer. Format for Manufacturer's Authorisation As per Annexure – 5 must be attached.

(o) Format for Distributor's Authorization As per Annexure – 6 must be attached.

(**p**) Declaration by Supplier as per annexure - 7

(q) Declaration for Acceptance of Tender Terms and Conditions As per Annexure – 8 must be

attached.

(r) Scanned copy of "List of Companies Quoted" as per Annexure – 11

(s) Details of clients where similar services are presently provided by the Tenderer separately for govt. and private clients.

(t) The bidder must have adequate experience of execution of similar work in Govt. offices / PSUs / Autonomous Bodies and other similar organizations. Necessary supporting documents like work orders, work completion certificate, payment certificate etc. for last three years to this effect must be submitted along with the offer.

(u) The concerned firm/company whose product has been declared as of spurious or adulterated quality and any criminal cases is filled and is pending in any court shall not be eligible to participate in the bidding process. Convicted firms/company shall also not be eligible to participate in the bid. Similarly, blacklisted / banned / debarred firms / company by any central / state govt. or its organization or autonomous bodies or central

drug procurement agency is not eligible to participate in the bid.

(v) Brochure, original technical catalogue with detailed specification and picture of the product offered, if relevant.

(w) The list of Chemicals, solvent, glassware's, etc... should be submitted in PDF along with the corresponding brand and authorization certificate issued by the OEM.

B. Financial Bid:

Price Schedule(s) as per given format filled up with all the details including Make, Model etc. of the goods offered to be forwarded.

6. Other terms & Conditions of the Contract

(a) The successful firm will be required to do the work / job for 1 year from the date of award of the contract and the same is extendable up to 02 years from the date of

Contract/Agreement. However, NFSU reserve the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason.

(b) The items will have to be supplied at NFSU Guwahati Campus. No transportation/ cartage charges will be paid for the same.

(c) The firm should supply the required items as per the unit price mentioned in the price list.

(d) The articles should be securely packed to avoid damages etc. in transit.

(e) National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU), Guwahati Campus shall be the sole authority to cancel or amend the order, as per requirement, and also to place an order for the supply of item beyond office hours/holidays/place of supply for which, no additional payment shall be made.

(f) In case a proposal is accepted the supplier/principal will have to sign an agreement deed with NFSU on a non-judicial stamp of appropriate value while entering into a rate contract.

(g) The firm should have the availability of a responsible person on call on all working days between 10:00 Hrs to 17.30 Hrs.

(h) The material shall be delivered at the NFSU Guwahati Campus with remaining shelf-life of at least 75% of the stipulated total shelf-life from the date of manufacturing of that product.

(i) Order shall be issued for tentative annual requirement on actual need basis. Bills in triplicate for the items supplied by the selected firm(s), should be raised for payment. Payment shall be released after it is ensured that the items/quantity and quality of items

supplied are to the entire satisfaction of this office and accepted. If any item is found to be defective, or not of the desired quality, the same shall be replaced immediately, for which no extra payment shall be made by NFSU, Guwahati Campus.

(j) The selected tendering Firm/Agency/Company shall also provide the name and mobile number of a key person, who can be contacted at any time, even beyond the office hours on holidays. The person should be capable of taking orders and making arrangement for supply of the desired items even on short notice to NFSU Guwahati Campus.

(k) In case the quality of goods supplied are not in conformity with the standard given in tender or the supplies are found defective at any stage these goods will be taken back by the supplier immediately and will be replaced with the prescribed tender quality goods, without any delay. The Purchase Committee reserves all right to reject the goods if the same is not found in accordance with the required description/specifications and liquidates damages shall be charged.

(1) Each page of the Tender Notice to be signed and stamped by the bidder in token of having accepted the same.

(m) Discount: The Discount which will be offered by the manufacturer/authorized distributors on the manufacturer's price list for the 1 year may be mentioned. Firms must offer a flat discount rate on all items instead of separate discount on different items like culture media, chemicals etc.

(n) GST: The rate of GST should be mentioned clearly.

(o) Authorization Letter: Authorization letter from the manufacturer for the current financial year should be submitted along-with quotation, failing which quotation will not be considered.

(**p**) The NFSU Guwahati Campus reserves the right to place an order for supply of any items mentioned in the Financial Bid or otherwise, to any other firm(s) in emergency/unavoidable situation.

(q) Disclaimer:

The near relatives of employees of NFSU Guwahati Campus are prohibited from participation in this tender. The near relative for this purpose are defined as:

(i) Members of a Hindu undivided Family.

(ii) Their spouses

(iii) The one related to the other in the manner as father, son(s), Son's wife (daughter-in law), daughter(s) and daughter's husband (sons-in-law) brother (s) and brother's wife,

sister(s) and sister's husband, brother(s)-in-law.

(r) Special Terms & conditions:

i. Freight, insurance charges, if any will be borne by the supplier, Similarly shortage, pilferage in transit will be sole responsibility of the supplier and the same will be intimated to the supplier on receipt of goods by the purchaser for resupply. The defective supply will have to be replaced by the supplier within 10 days without additional freight / transport charge.

ii. GST and other Govt. levies will be paid extra as applicable by the supplier.

iii. Delivery of goods will be taken at the risk and cost of the supplier and on F.O.R. basis to the Institute from railway / road transport.

iv. Payment of the bill will be made preferably after receipt of the goods in satisfactory condition.

v. No revision in rate (on higher side) will be accepted during contract period.

vi. Order will be placed as per requirement, irrespective of value of the order.

vii. Supply should be made in full against the order and shortage will be procured from other supplier on the risk and cost of the original supplier.

viii. Supply should be made from the latest batch of production with maximum life period & original packing.

ix. While submitting the tender document, the tenderer should sign on each page of the tender document.

x. The Tenderer should enclose a signed copy of the terms & conditions stipulated for award of the contract, conveying his acceptance of the same.

(s) Inspection:

(i) NFSU Bhopal Campus shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the NFSU Tender Specifications at no extra cost to the NFSU,

Guwahati Campus.

(ii) NFSU Guwahati Campus right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the goods arrival at the final destination shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by NFSU Guwahati Campus prior to the goods shipment.

(iii) The Campus Director, NFSU Guwahati Campus shall be the final authority to reject full or any part of the supply which is not confirming to the specification and other terms and conditions.

(iv) No payment shall be made for rejected Stores. Rejected items must be removed by the Bidders within two (02) weeks of the date of rejection at their own cost and replaced immediately.

7. TECHNICAL EVALUATION:

(a) Detailed technical evaluation shall be carried out by Purchase Committee pursuant to conditions in the tender document to determine the substantial responsiveness of each tender. For this clause, the substantially responsive bid is one that conforms to all the eligibility and terms and condition of the tender without any material deviation. The Institute's determination of bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence. The Institute shall evaluate the technical bids also to determine whether they are complete, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are in order.

(b) The technical evaluation committee may call the responsive bidders for discussion or presentation to facilitate and assess their understanding of the scope of work and its execution. However, the committee shall have sole discretion to call for discussion / presentation.

(c) Financial bids of only those bidders who qualify the technical criteria will be opened provided all other requirements are fulfilled.

(d) NFSU Guwahati Campus shall have right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.

8. FINANCIAL EVALUATION:

(a) The financial bid shall be opened of only those bidders who are found to be technically eligible.

(b) Arithmetical errors shall be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and total price that is, the unit price shall prevail and the total

price shall be corrected by the Institute. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the lesser amount shall be considered as valid. If the Supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, his bid shall be rejected.

(c) The NFSU Guwahati Campus does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any bid and reserves the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid or portion of the job offered; and the bidder shall provide the same at the rates quoted. NFSU Guwahati Campus, reserves the right to reject any or all offers received in response to tender or cancel or withdraw the tender notice without assigning any reason, whatsoever.

9. AWARD OF CONTRACT: PLACEMENT OF ORDER

The Institute shall consider placement of orders for jobs on those bidders whose offers have been found technical, commercially and financially acceptable. The Institute reserves the right to counter offer price(s) against price(s) quoted by any bidder. L1 will be decided on individual item basis.

10. Integrity Pact (On Bidder's letterhead) INTEGRITY PACT

a) General

WHEREAS the BUYER proposes to procure **Annual Rate Contract** and the BIDDER/Seller is willing to offer/has offered the stores and WHEREAS the BIDDER is a private company/public company/Government undertaking/partnership/registered export agency, constituted in accordance with the relevant law in the matter and the BUYER is an Autonomous Body/Department of the Government of India performing its functions on behalf of the President of India.

NOW, THEREFORE, to avoid all forms of corruption by following a system that is fair, transparent and free from any influence/prejudiced dealings prior to, during and subsequent to the currency of the contract to be entered into with a view to enabling the BUYER to obtain the desired said stores / equipment at a competitive price in conformity with the defined specifications by avoiding the high cost and the distortionary impact of corruption on public procurement, and Enabling BIDDERs to abstain from bribing or indulging in any corrupt practice in order to secure the contract by providing assurance to them that their competitors will also abstain from bribing and other corrupt practices and the BUYER will commit to prevent corruption, in any form, by its officials by following transparent procedures.

The parties hereby agree to enter into this Integrity Pact and agree as follows:

b) Commitments of the BUYER:

The BUYER undertakes that no official of the BUYER, connected directly or indirectly with the contract, will demand, take a promise for or accept, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favor or any material or immaterial benefit or any other advantage from the BIDDER, either for themselves or for any person,

organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for an advantage in the

bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting or implementation process related to the Contract. The BUYER will, during the pre-contract stage, treat all BIDDERs alike, and will provide to all BIDDERs the same information and will not provide any such information to any particular BIDDER which could afford an advantage to that particular BIDDER in comparison to other BIDDERs

All the officials of the Buyer will report to the appropriate Government office any attempted or completed breaches of the above commitments as well as any substantial suspicion of such a breach.

In case any such preceding misconduct on the part of such official (s) is reported by the BIDDER to the BUYER, with full and verifiable facts and the same is prima facie found to be correct by the BUYER, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings may be initiated by the BUYER and such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to the contract process. In such a case while an enquiry is being conducted by the BUYER the proceedings under the contract would not be stalled.

c) Commitments of BIDDERs:

The BIDDER commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of its bid or during any pre-contract or post-contract stage in order to secure the contract or in furtherance to secure it and in particular commit itself to the following:

The BIDDER will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favor, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the BUYER, connected directly or indirectly with the bidding process, or to any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for any advantage in the bidding, evaluation, contracting and implementation of the Contract.

The BIDDER further undertakes that it has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favor, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the BUYER or otherwise in procuring the Contract or forbearing to do or having done any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the Contract or any other Contract with the Government for showing or forbearing to show favor or disfavor to any person in relation to the Contract or any other Contract with the Government.

BIDDERs shall disclose the name and address of agents and representatives and Indian BIDDERs shall disclose their foreign principals or associates.

BIDDERs shall disclose the payments to be made by them to agents / brokers or any other intermediary, in connection with this bid/contract.

The BIDDER further confirms and declares to the BUYER that the BIDDER is the original manufacturer/ integrator/ authorized government sponsored export entity of the defence stores and has not engaged any individual or firm or company whether Indian or foreign to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the BUYER, or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially to the award of the contract to the BIDDER, nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual, firm or company in respect of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation.

The BIDDER, either while presenting the bid or during pre-contract negotiations or before signing the contract, shall disclose any payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to officials of the BUYER or their family members, agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the contract and the details of services agreed upon for such payments. The BIDDER will not collude with other parties interested in the contract to impair the transparency, fairness and progress of the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting and implementation of the contract.

The BIDDER will not accept any advantage in exchange for any corrupt practice, unfair means and illegal activities.

The BIDDER shall not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information provided by the BUYER as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained in any electronic data carrier. The BIDDER also undertakes to exercise due and adequate care lest any such information is divulged.

The BIDDER commits to refrain from giving any complaint directly or through any other manner without supporting it with full and verifiable facts.

The BIDDER shall not instigate or cause to instigate any third person to commit any of the actions mentioned above.

If the BIDDER or any employee of the BIDDER or any person acting on behalf of the BIDDER, either directly or indirectly, is a relative of any of the officers of the BUYER, or alternatively, if any relative of an officer of the BUYER has financial interest/stake in the BIDDER's firm, the same shall be disclosed by the BIDDER at the time of filing of tender. The term relative for this purpose would be as defined in Section 6 of the Companies Act1956.

The BIDDER shall not lend to or borrow any money from or enter into any monetary dealings or transactions, directly or indirectly, with any employee of the BUYER.

d) Previous Transgression

The BIDDER declares that no previous transgression occurred in the last three years immediately before signing of this Integrity Pact, with any other company in any country in respect of any corrupt practices envisaged hereunder or with any Public Sector Enterprise in India or any Government Department in India that could justify BIDDER's exclusion from the tender process.

The BIDDER agrees that if it makes incorrect statement on this subject, BIDDER can be disqualified from the tender process or the contract, if already awarded, can be terminated for such reason.

e) Earnest Money Deposit

While submitting bid, the BIDDER shall deposit an amount mentioned in tender document as Earnest Money, with the University through any one of the following instruments:

i. Fixed Deposit Receipt

ii. A confirmed Bank Guarantee by an Indian Nationalized Bank, promising payment of the guaranteed sum to the BUYER on demand within three working days without any demur whatsoever and without seeking any reasons whatsoever. The demand

for payment by the University shall be treated as conclusive proof of payment. The Earnest Money is normally to remain valid for a period of 90 (ninety) days

beyond the date prescribed for the receipt of the tender. No interest shall be payable by the BUYER to the BIDDER on Earnest Money for the period of its currency. In case of successful BIDDER, EMD will be returned within 30 days from the date of submission of Performance Bank Guarantee.

f) Security Deposit /Performance Guarantee:

a. Performance Bank Guarantee is mandatory.

b. Successful Tenderer/ bidder should submit performance guarantee as prescribed above to be received in the office of Campus Director, National Forensic Sciences University, Guwahati Campus on or before 30 days from the date of issue of order acknowledgement.

The performance bank guarantee to be furnished in the form of Bank Guarantee as per the tender documents, for an amount covering 10% of the purchase order value.

c. The Performance Bank Guarantee should be established in favor of **"The Campus Director, NFSU, Guwahati Campus"** through any Bank situated at Guwahati Campus or outstation with a clause to be enforced the same on their local branch at Guwahati.

d. Performance Bank Guarantee shall be for the due and faithful performance of the contract and shall remain binding, notwithstanding such variations, alterations for extensions of time as may be made, given, conceded or agreed to between the successful Tenderer and the purchaser under the terms and conditions of acceptance to tender.

e. The successful Tenderer is entirely responsible for due performance of the contract in all respects according to the speed, intent and meaning of the terms and conditions and specification and all other documents referred to in the acceptance of tender.

f. The performance bank guarantee shall be kept valid during the entire period of the contract and shall continue to be enforceable for a period of 90 days beyond the date of fulfillment of all contractual obligations including warranty period.

g) Sanctions For Violations

Any breach of the aforesaid provisions by the BIDDER or any one employed by it or acting on its behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the BIDDER) shall entitle the BUYER to take all or any one of the following actions, wherever required:

(i) To immediately call off the pre-contract negotiations without assigning any reason or giving any compensation to the BIDDER. However, the proceedings with the other BIDDER(s) would continue.

(ii) The Earnest Money Deposit (in pre-contract stage) and/or Security Deposit/Performance Bank Guarantee (after the contract is signed) shall stand forfeited either fully or partially, as decided by the BUYER and the BUYER shall not be required to assign any reason therefore.

(iii) To immediately cancel the contract, if already signed without giving any compensation to the BIDDER.

(iv) To recover all sums already paid by the BUYER, and in case of an Indian BIDDER with interest thereon at 2% higher than the prevailing Prime Lending Rate of State Bank of India, while in case of a BIDDER from a country other than India with interest thereon at 2% higher than the LIBOR. If any outstanding payment is due to the BIDDER from the BUYER in connection with any other contract for any other stores, such outstanding payment could also be utilized to recover the aforesaid sum and interest.

(v) To encase the advance bank guarantee and performance guarantee/warranty bond, if furnished by the BIDDER, in order to recover the payments, already made by the BUYER, along with interest.

(vi) To cancel all or any other contracts with the BIDDER. The BIDDER shall be liable to pay compensation for any loss or damage to the BUYER resulting from such cancellation/rescission and the BUYER shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from the money(s) due to the BIDDER.

(vii) To debar the BIDDER from participating in future bidding processes of the Government of India for a minimum period of two years, which may be further extended at the discretion of the BUYER.

(viii) To recover all sums paid in violation of this pact by the BIDDER(s) to any middleman or agent or broker with a view to securing the contract.

(ix) In cases where irrevocable Letters of Credit have been received in respect of any contract signed by the BUYER with the BIDDER, the same shall not be opened.

(x) Forfeiture of Performance Bank Guarantee in case of a decision by the BUYER to forfeit the same without assigning any reason for imposing sanction for violation of this Pact. The BUYER will be entitled to take all or any of the actions mentioned at para 7.1(i) to (x) of this Pact also on the Commission by the BIDDER or any one employed by it or acting on its behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the BIDDER), of an offence as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal code, 1860 or Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 or any other statute enacted for prevention of corruption. The decision of the BUYER to the effect that a breach of the provisions of this pact has been committed by the BIDDER shall be final and conclusive on the BIDDER. However, the BIDDER can approach the independent monitor(s) appointed for the purposes of this pact.

h) Fall Clause

The BIDDER undertakes that it has not supplied/is not supplying similar product/systems or subsystems at a price lower than that offered in the present bid in respect of any other Ministry/ Department of the Government of India or PSU or autonomous body and if it is found at any stage that similar product/system or subsystem was supplied by the BIDDER to any other Ministry/Department of the Government of India or PSU or autonomous body at a lower price, then that very price, with due allowance for elapsed time, will be applicable to the present case and the difference in the cost would be refunded by the BIDDER to the BUYER, if the contract has already been concluded.

i) Independent monitors

a. The BUYER appointed Independent Monitors (hereinafter referred to as Monitors) for this pact in consultation with the Central Vigilance Commission (Chief Vigilance Officer, NFSU).

b. The task of the Monitor shall be to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this pact.

c. The Monitor shall not be subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs their functions neutrally and independently.

d. Both the parties accept that the Monitor have the right to access all the documents relating to the project/procurement, including minutes of the meetings.

e. As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this pact, he will so inform the Authority designated by the BUYER.

f. The BIDDER(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all project documentation of the BUYER including that provided by the BIDDER. The BIDDER will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to subcontractors. The Monitor shall be under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the BIDDER/Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.

g. The BUYER will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the parties. The parties will offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.

h. The Monitor will submit a written report to the designated Authority of BUYER/ Secretary in the Department within 08 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the BUYER / BIDDER and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.

j) Facilitation of Investigation

In case of any allegation of violation of any provisions of this pact or payment of

commission, the BUYER or its agencies shall be entitled to examine all the documents including the Books of Accounts of the BIDDER and the BIDDER shall provide necessary information & documents in English and shall extend all possible help for the purpose of such examination.

k) Law and Place of Jurisdiction

This Pact is subject to Indian Law. The place of performance and Jurisdiction is Assam. **I) Other Legal Actions**

The actions stipulated in this Integrity Pact are without prejudice to any other legal action that may follow in accordance with the provisions of the extant law in force relating to any civil or criminal proceedings.

m) Validity

a. The validity of this Integrity Pact shall be from date of its signing and extend upto 5 years or the complete execution of the contract to the satisfaction of both the BUYER and the BIDDER/Seller, including warranty period, whichever is later. In case BIDDER is unsuccessful, this Integrity Pact shall expire after six months from the date of the signing of the contract.

b. Should one or several provisions of this pact turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.

n) The parties hereby sign this Integrity Pact.
